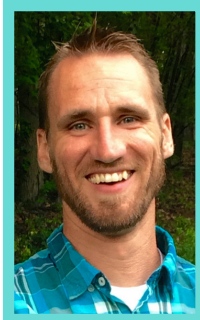
WT-A: JIM EHRMAN
