**CAMP WEEK** – For most camps the program begins with registration on Sunday at 2:30 PM (no earlier please!) and closes at 10:00 AM the following Saturday (unless stated otherwise). Please be sure to arrange to pick up your camper by 10:00 AM. The following camps have different end closing times.  
– **My First Camp, Father 'n' Son and Moms 'n' Gals** begin on **Wednesday at 7:00 PM** and close on **Saturday at 10:00 AM**  
– **Young Adult Camp** begins on **Thursday, July 2** between **6:00 and 8:00 PM**
